## Member Story Amie



Amie was a healthy 34-year-old when she suddenly started experiencing pain in her lower abdomen in December 2013. At first she ignored it, but the pain eventually became excruciating and also migrated to her lower back

By March 2014, the pain was so severe it had become unbearable and she could no longer sit at work. Her doctor prescribed painkillers so strong that Amie couldn't drive while on them, could no longer work and had to go on disability.

Amie underwent a battery of tests, including more ultrasounds as well as MRIs and CT scans. These tests showed there was something on Amie's lower back, although it wasn't clear what this was. Meanwhile, Amie's pain continued to become increasingly severe.

"My doctor was just prescribing higher doses of the painkillers to ease the pain which just wasn't fixing the issue," Amie recalled. The drugs took a heavy toll on her, making it impossible for her to function properly.

At this point her doctor sent her to a gynecologist, who sent her to another gynecologist. "I got passed around quite a bit," Amie said, adding that the doctors believed the fibroid was the source of her issues. One gynecolo-gist suggested that it be removed, while

conceding that she "couldn't guarantee that that was the problem or that was going to fix it," according to Amie.

Hesitant to undergo surgery, Amie decided to contact Teladoc Medical Experts, a benefit to which she had access through her individual insurance policy.

"It just seemed like I wasn't with the right doctor," Amie said.

That gynecologist suggested performing exploratory surgery to see if the fibroid was indeed the source of Amie's problems. The goal was to find out whether it was a "healthy" fibroid or not. Amie underwent the procedure in June 2014 and the gynecologist found that the fibroid was in fact healthy, was not causing any issues and could be left intact.

"When they told me that, it was probably one of the most upsetting moments of the whole process," Amie said. "I was led down the gynecology path the whole time and that wasn't the issue at all."

She called Teladoc Medical Experts so that they would have the latest information and she then waited to receive the Teladoc Medical Experts report.

Amie's case was reviewed by a Teladoc Medical Experts gynecologist in North Carolina as well as an orthopedic surgeon in San Francisco who specializes in spinal surgery. Imaging studies revealed a subtle tear in one of her disc walls, as well as a small herniation in another disc which was on the same side as where she experienced her pain.
